PAST SIMPLE

She went to school yesterday.



We **DON'T** change verbs into their Past Simple forms when they are used in the following situations.



1 Questions:

"Did she **go** to school yesterday?"



2 Negative Statements:

"She didn't go to school yesterday."

3 After the word 'to':

"She wanted to **go** to school yesterday."

4 After 'modals'*:

"She could **go** to school yesterday."

*(also sometimes called 'helping' verbs, or 'auxiliary' verbs)
