## -EVER

- **Whatever, Whenever, Wherever and Whoever** are used to show that something does not matter.

For example:

"You should do **whatever** you can to fix the problem."

"I will clean my room **whenever** I have time."

"**Wherever** you decide to go, call me and let me know."

You can bring **whoever** you like to the party."

Answers will vary.

Some possible answers:

1. We'll go **wherever** you like.
2. **Whatever** you decide is okay.
3. Let's have a meeting **whenever** we can.
4. I exercise **wherever** I can.
5. We should ask **whoever** can fix it.
6. You can invite **whoever** you like.
7. You can arrive **whenever** you want.
8. You can buy **whatever** you like.

### NOTE:

Also "However" and (less commonly) "Whyever"

For example:

"You can arrange the room *however* you like."

"*Whyever* did you do that?"

## Grades as percentages
