ACTIVITY NOTES

Consider following up this vocabulary activity with a short opinion discussion activity (10 minutes). Ask your learners to choose what they think are the seven most important kinds of transportation from the list and then number them (with a pen or pencil) from 1 to 7, ranking them from most important to least important. Finally, have your students compare and discuss their answers in small groups – make sure they give reasons.
