Part 1 (listen and write)

Distribute the handout (page 1) to your students, and then dictate the questions on page 2. Make sure your students understand that, for many of the questions, there may be two possible answers (for example, Q: "Do you usually eat breakfast? A: "Yes, I do," or "No, I don't.")

Part 2

Distribute page 2 (one half to each student) so they can check their answers.
